I would strongly like to advise the boundaries of Penn ward are left as they are for a number of reasons. I am a resident of Coalway Road. 1. The availability of an acceptable and clearly defined set of geographical boundaries is important for people to find us. The Coalway road provides a clear boundary for the Penn ward area. The suggested changes leave Penn Ward no strong or clearly defined boundaries. 2. To change the boundary I believe would have a detrimental affect on my property price. We specifically bought this house because it was in the Penn area. The area remains a popular and sought after place to live. To change the boundary would affect me and many others along the Coalway road financially. 3. This may also have a detrimental affect on businesses along the road and cause confusion in finding them. 4. There are a number of shops along the Coalway road which add to the profile of the local area. To remove these would have a detrimental affect on the local community identity. The ward we are proposed to move into (Graisley) already has its own local profile and shopping areas. 5. Penn ward boundaries should be maintained as they currently are, as it has similarities with Merry Hill Tettenhall Regis, Tettenhall Wightwick as these 3 wards are already recommended by Lgbce and the local council to remain as they are. 6. The criteria to consider our local community identity has been ignored. A change in boundary would cause the community's only Catholic Church to be lost, this would have a significant affect on our local identity. 7. The average number of electorates in the ward per councillor is 3175 and if the ward is kept as is, this is broadly in line with other wards, and within the acceptable range.
