Penn Ward boundaries are clearly defined currently and have similarities with Merry Hill ,Tettenhall Regis and Tettenhall Wightwick(wards which are recommended by LGBCE and the local council to remain as they are) The test around clear boundaries is definitely compromised as relinquishing both sides of the Coalway Road to Graiseley,and taking both sides of Goldthorn Hill and Coton Road to Blakenhall will leave Penn Ward no strong,clearly identifiable boundaries. The other test around reflecting community identity has been ignored.Penn Ward will lose its well loved and only Catholic Church St Michaels which currently comes under Penn Ward and Penn residents are proud of this. Average number of electors is 3175 per Councillor -the proposal to leave Penn Ward as it is will still leave Councillors with electors within the range of 10% of the average electors over the forecast period of 2026,as evidenced. Penn Ward has some lovely shops like Tantastic and others which will be lost to the Penn Ward -these shops form the character of The Penn Ward of which we are all proud to call home.The other wards already have their own community shopping areas.
