### Comment text:

I would definitely be opposed to everywhere south of the railway line being cut off from Lenham village and being included with Headcorn in any new ward changes. We in Sandway look to Lenham for all our services. It's just a mile away. We are already pretty miffed at having to vote in the tiny village hall (with no parking) at Platts Heath, which is double the distance. Platts Heath, Liverton Hill and Lenham Heath also regard Lenham at their service centre (to use council jargon). We would absolutely object to being separated from Lenham and represented from Headcorn, which we rarely visit and whose councillors would have no incentive to represent us. Our doctor is in Lenham, dentist in Lenham, railway station in Lenham, schools, church, pubs, shops all in Lenham. To suggest otherwise is outrageous - on a par with MBC's plan to plonk a new town at Lenham Heath. In fact, is this a way of achieving that objective? If anything Lenham Heath should join up with Charing Heath - they already share a village Hall and church and they used to share a school. This at least would have a historical basis as Lenham Heath was part of the Cale Hill Hundred along with Charing Heath (and Charing).
