As a Mickleover Resident, it is frustrating to see four large estates built on the outskirts of the Derby City boundary, with no powers to influence the build, consult on etc. Derby City Council do not receive the Council Tax from these four large estates, as it goes to Amber Valley, South Derbyshire District Council. However all residents use Mickleover village services, petrol station, Tesco, etc, it is at breaking point and Derby City are left to foot the bills to improve services for residents, when income on the properties is not received. If we extend the boundary to include the new estates on the A516, Hackwood Farm Estate on Radbourne Lane and Langley Park across the road from Mackworth estate, this would bring in more income to DCC and help with the necessary infrastructure improvements, which are urgently required.
