I am writing to you to express my objection to the proposed changes which have been put forward to the Astley Bridge Ward in Bolton. The Astley Bridge community has a proud and long history and is one of the oldest parts of Bolton and I feel it is wrong that this area should be split up, destroying such a historic community. Astley Bridge and Sharples area has a strong commitment to one another, having held many community events over the years, including Remembrance displays and an Easter Egg Hunt. If the decision to split this community up goes forward, then these activities will no longer be able to take place in the way they currently do. The removal of focal points such as Andrew Lane Park from the ward would mean residents will lose out and the strong community that has existed for so long would be damaged. In addition, your proposals would mean that many residents will no longer live within the existing ward but would still be dependent on local facilities such as shops, community hubs and local churches, which would remain within the existing ward. Residents in the areas which are proposed to be moved belong in Astley Bridge.
