I disagree with the concept of "thirds" such that one third of councillors standing for reelection. This is devised every year to allow a new council to establish itself and the purdah creates further unnecessary disruption. This also has an impact on boundaries whereby wards must have three councillors each. In the event that the decision to vote for councillors by thirds the optimum solution is to combine Brockham, Betchworth and Buckland which currently has two councillors with Boxhill and Headley which has one councillor and brings the total number of voters to approximately 5750. There is much synergy in combining these wards as is well set out in the consultation response from Buckland Parish Council. This provides an elegant solution in preference to any thought of dividing the current Brockham, Betchworth and Buckland ward or combining them in some way with wards to the south. In the case of the latter, these wards do not have the same interests and common issues.
