Good evening, I would like to add a few comments to your consultation please. As a resident of Buckland, I think it is important that the 3B's, as they are affectionately known locally, remain as one ward. There is a strong community inter-connectedness between the three villages with mutually supportive activities, clubs and businesses. As an example of this, my son goes to North Downs school in Brockham even though we live close to the border with Reigate in Buckland. Our churches, clubs and pubs are all well-connected and identify their communities coming from across the 3 villages. Therefore, I think strongly that we should remain together. If a solution has to be found, based on the imperative to have 3-councillor wards, then the glaringly obvious move is to merge Boxhill & Headley in with the 3Bs. Again, there are solid reasons to do so, not least that both wards have common challenges in forming the A25 border communities between Dorking & Reigate and are also washed over by the Green Belt and/or within the AoNB. As a local active cyclist, I use the roads up over Boxhil frequently, I as do many cyclists who come out of London and take the route from Reigate along the A25.
