### Comment text:

I live in Oakwood and fully support the proposals laid out for the boundary changes to Oakwood and Chaddesden. As a growing area of the city we need to keep three councillors to look after our interests. If the number was reduced to two they would not have the time to take part in local community groups and listen to the thoughts and problems of the residents. We would be severely under represented when numbers of residents increase, as they are bound to do with all the new houses being built around Oakwood. It does not make sense to include Western Oakwood with Breadsall Hilltop. There is no synergy of demographics and we should keep like minded residents in the same ward, so that the councillors can look after the best interests of all residents and not just some. It also makes good sense to keep western Oakwood with the rest of Oakwood so that any future residential developments will have a say from the councillors representing the other residents of Oakwood that surround that area. There are also considerations that need to be taken into account for the future of Chaddesden woods. If more residential development is to take place, the wildlife access to the woods is of vital importance. Our councillors must have a say in any new development. I reiterate that I support in Full the draft proposals of the boundary changes for Oakwood ward in the City of Derby.
