### Comment text:

I am objecting to the late proposal by the Labour Councillors to alter the arrangements that were previously agreed by a majority of all parties elected to the Derby City Council. A consensus of all parties agreed to keep three councillors per ward and 51 councillors in total - figures that were passed to the Boundary Commission and accepted by it. It is of particular interest to me as I live in the Alvaston area - the proposed division of this area into several smaller sections is not necessary and serves no purpose as far as the population are concerned. We have been very well served by our three councillors over many years and no change is needed or welcomed. Three councillors per ward is sufficient and to bring in sweeping unneeded changes at a time when restraint in all spending is essential makes no sense whatsoever. It should also be noted that although the Alvaston ward is large by comparison with some of the other wards, a considerable percentage of the area is occupied by industrial premises and hence is not populated by domestic housing. The arrangements were agreed early on in this negotiation and they should be adhered to without exception.
