### Comment text:

As a resident of Wick, I oppose the proposal to redraw the parliamentary boundary of Fladbury ward, moving the village of Wick into Pershore ward. This is a small rural village which has issues in common with the other villages in Fladbury ward. The residents of Wick number about 350, and our concerns and voices would be lost if we were to become a tiny part of a large town ward of over 7200, with its very different concerns and issues. The bridge and river Avon that divides us physically from the town means that this side of the river is not urban but farming countryside. It has worked well enough for a number of years having the grouping that we currently have, with one councillor to represent us. There is a strong sense of community in Wick, with many voluntary groups and our own licenced club. I feel it would be detrimental to the representation of our village if we were severed from the grouping with other rural villages and added to Pershore.
