Comment on Drakes Broughton proposals This has been my home since 1971. I was the ward councillor for 12 years and served as Chairman of Wychavon DC. I cannot support the idea that Drakes Broughton is more like a small town any more than Broadway or Inkberrow. Though much larger than when its development started in 1964, it retains all the traditional elements of a village, i.e. 4 shops, a church, primary school, public house, Parish Council, playing field and many village organisations catering for all age groups and using the thriving Village Hall. Other commercial activity is very largely composed of individuals trading from their homes. Apart from its three towns - Droitwich, Evesham and Pershore - it is difficult to see any of Wychavon as Urban. In my view, the existing ward - plus Peopleton (another village that looks to Pershore) - is the best option, even if Peopleton's community links are not stronger than with other communities. I am strongly of the opinion that single member wards are infinitely preferable to two- member wards. Further afield, joining Norton and Whittington seems viable in view of future building developments.
