Comment text:

I have been an active resident here since 1977 and, from long service as a school governor and long -term involvement with Residents Associations, have experience and knowledge of local government in the area. I am of the opinion that Ruxley Ward should not be reduced in its size and number of representatives from its current levels. The wards of Ruxley and Court have some of the highest levels of deprivation in the borough and also in Surrey, as evidenced in Surrey-i and census figures. The work of our local councillors includes a large element of support for those people in the greatest need and this element of the workload is likely to increase as the country continues to face the longer term effects of the pandemic. The retention of the boundary along Gadesden Rd/Green constitutes an easily identifiable edge to the ward, which is currently well served by buses E5, 418 and 467. With the ward relatively unchanged, there is continued scope for more social cohesion.keeping Ruxley big would not lessen its voice in the Council Chamber. e
