### Comment text:

My comments are as follows: I disagree with the Commission's proposals, in particular that they create a significantly geographically larger combined Ward in the East of the District. The current Ward is already very large in area which means it is already onerous for our elected Councillor to efficiently represent as it has many Parishes contained within it. The Commission's proposal is for a Ward which stretches from close to the M40 in the West, including Bishops Itchington, to Shuckburgh in the East, and from Shotteswell in the South to Napton in the North and which would be an unworkable area, even if it was a two member Ward. I believe it is unfortunate that this proposal is only focussing on balancing the number of electors represented by a single District Councillor. There is a clear difference between the potential work load including travel & attendance at many more meetings of a District Councillor operating in a predominantly Rural setting when compared with one operating in a densely populated town, as is the case in point with this particular Ward and hence I would ask that this proposal is reviewed before any decision is made.
