Dear Sirs,

I make the following comments relating to the existing "Lovett & North Claines" ward as proposed by the Boundary commission.

I have no problems with Elmley Lovett PC and Elmbridge PC being placed in another ward.

I believe the proposals for Hampton Lovett are unacceptable as it splits up a valuable community. Specific points are:

- Doverdale Park homes are integrated with Hampton Lovett, using the village hall for meetings and social events and the church for weddings, funerals and services. It has no community links with Droitwich. (Para 51&52 in the report)
- The employment area around Pointon Way and Wassage Way also have connections with Hampton & Westwood PC in that relationships are being forged to improve the environment and to provide funding for local projects.
- The Parish Council already has 7 councillors made up of 4 from Hampton Lovett and 3 from Westwood , not 5 as mentioned in para 104. The proposal for 2 Councillors each from Hampton and Wassage and 1 from Westwood is unacceptable if the village is to remain a cohesive unit. In any case as far as we know, there are no people living in "Wassage".

Because of these factors, I would propose that Hampton Lovett and Westwood keep their Parish Boundaries and be included in Ombersley ward rather than be split up.
