### Comment text:

I live in Little Comberton Civil Parish which traditionally fell within the Elmley Castle & Somerville Ward. Bredon Hill has nine principal satellite settlements which together form a strong cohesive socio-cultural unit which is easy to represent. It makes no sense whatsoever to separate Little Comberton from Great Comberton and therefore from the rest of the nine principal settlements around the periphery of Bredon Hill. Given that Little Comberton falls within the Cotswold AONB and that Bredon Hill is single obvious topographic feature it is difficult to countenance any reason why and how it might fall within a ward known as 'Fladbury' most of which has no direct affinity with Bredon Hill. My view is that the new Ward should be called Bredon Hill and should include Little Comberton a matter so obvious that it is difficult to imagine why it has been overlooked. The new Bredon Hill ward should include the settlements of Great Comberton, Little Comberton, Ashton-under-Hill, Kersoe Elmley Castle, Overbury, Bredon, Bredon's Norton, Kemerton and Beckford. The southern boundary of the proposed Fladbury Ward should be reviewed. The part of proposed Bredon Ward that runs down almost to Tewkesbury seems somewhat problematic; further consideration may be required here as to just how closely it would conform with a proposed Bredon Hill Ward; it might work. If the Little Comberton problem is rationalised along the suggested lines it is difficult to see why more than one Councillor would be required although he or she would clearly need to be capable.
