My wife and I wish to comment on the Boundary Commission report of revisions to Ward boundaries in Wychavon in so far as Great Comberton is concerned. Their statement that there is no evidence of community links between us and Little Comberton suggests that very little effort has been made to establish the actual situation. Had the comment been made concerning links between Great Comberton and Eckington we could have accepted the statement but it is most certainly not the case between Great and Little Comberton. In this respect we wish to support the views expressed in the submission from Little Comberton Parish Council but to extend the comments on links with the following

The churches of Great and Little Comberton, together with those of Bricklehampton and Elmley Castle, form a single parish whose affairs are governed by a single PCC whose members are drawn from all four churches. The congregation at the weekly service will be drawn from all four churches wherever the service is held that week – the choir likewise.

There are also a number of activities which are jointly supported by residents of both Great and Little Comberton, including a choir, and activities held in Great Comberton village hall such as WI regularly are attended by Little Comberton residents.

We believe that the situations of Great and Little Comberton are very similar and we consider the current proposal to place the village with Eckington would not be in our best interest.
