Within the Hexham wards, there are streets where one side is within the central ward, and the other side is within the east ward - for example Hallstile Bank. These kind of anomalies should be tidied up. Also - given that residents in the market town of Hexham use facilities all across Hexham (schools in West area, hospital in East area, Market Place shopping in Central area), does it really make sense to have separate wards - rather than 3 councillors for the entire town? Should just one ward councillor be 'in charge' of the new high and middle schools? Should just one ward councillor be 'in charge' of Hexham Market Place and associated primary shopping areas?
