Comment text:

We recently heard from a neighbour that there maybe changes to the Electoral Ward Boundary between Gerrards Cross and Chalfont St Peter and we to object to this proposal. If we hadn't discovered this from our neighbour we would never have known. It seems to have been kept suspiciously quiet. We believe we should have received a letter regarding this in a similar manner to the recent revised parking proposals. We have lived in Gerrards Cross for 13 years and currently live at Beaumore Place, South Park View. It takes about seven minutes to walk to the town centre but about 30 minutes to Chalfont St Peter! We strongly believe that we're residents of Gerrards Cross not Chalfont St Peter in terms of the train station, schools, friends, shopping facilities and community events such as those held over the summer on the common. It is suggested the proposal will ensure the boundaries will reflect the identity of the community, but it certainly will not. Our road is part of Gerrards Cross not Chalfont St Peter. We have an affinity to Gerrards Cross and have ties here but no sense of belonging towards Chalfont St Peter, we do not identify with that town in any way. It was also suggested that Chalfont St Peter has already absorbed roads split by a boundary. This is not the case for South Park View or other surrounding roads. This area has always been fully integrated into the Gerrards Cross Ward. Additionally these roads are part of the Gerrards Cross Centenary Conservation Area. It's impossible to be thought of as being integrated but yet split away into a Chalfont St Peter Ward. We believe, the proposal doesn't reflect community ties or for our part of Gerrards Cross. We feel most strongly about this and ask that the proposal does not proceed as it would damage our local community. [REDACTED]
