Dear Sir/Madam, I do not agree with the proposal to split Fulmer from Gerrards Cross. We have lived in Fulmer for over ten years and are very much part of the community in Gerrards Cross. My daughter currently attends Fulmer nursery and will likely attend Gerrards Cross C.E. school. In terms of schooling, our house in Fulmer falls within the catchment area of Gerrards Cross, and not Stoke Poges, Wexham or Farnham Common. When my daughter was an infant we attended baby groups within the Gerrards Cross Memorial Centre and we regularly attend annual Fireworks, Fun Run and Christmas events in Gerrards Cross. We visit the Gerrards Cross Common Playground weekly. We are registered with Oak End dental, an NHS dentist in Gerrards Cross, do our weekly shop at the Tesco, or the Waitrose and take the train from Gerrards Cross into London. We use the local coffee shops such as Gails, borrow books from the library, go to the restaurants, WHSmith, photo shop and Screwfix on Packhouse Road. We donate clothes to Banados.
