## Currently there are:

- 42 councillors
- 20 wards
- Six three-councillor, 10 twocouncillor, four single-councillors per ward

A public consultation is open until 7 August 2023

We aim to make sure Tandridge councillors represent a similar number of electors


## Currently there are:

- One ward that is more than $10 \%$ away from the average number of electors per ward
- No ward that is more than $30 \%$ away from the average


## We are proposing:

- 42 councillors
- 15 wards
- 13 three-councillor, one twocouncillor, one single-councillor per ward


Our proposals mean that:

- One ward will be more than 10\% away from the average number of electors per ward
- Each councillor will represent an average of I,692 electors
