We are most grateful for the care that has been put in to this review and certainly understand the reasoning behind many of the conclusions that have been drawn at this stage.

It is our view that the inclusion of Woodford as a part of the Thrapston Ward was unwise, in view of that village's more natural affinity to Finedon and Irthlingborough.

As we have referenced before, the Thrapston Ward is nearly optimal in terms of the numbers of residents being served by the Councillors allocated and, as such, no major change seems necessary in that regard.

We also draw your attention to the importance of the boundary of the River Nene, which has delineated ward boundaries for many years and with previous local authorities.

Therefore, it is our respectful submission that the Thrapston Ward give up Tansor and Cotterstock parishes to the Oundle Ward, but retain the parish of Warmington, while leaving the parish of Woodford in its existing Ward.
