Dear Sir/Madam

I object to the draft plan on the proposed boundary review of the Tandridge area in particular putting Stafford Road , Stafford Rise, Stafford Close and Milner Road in Caterham Valley into the Queens Park ward which is very clearly on Caterham Hill. Stafford Road etc are very firmly in the valley and it would be ridiculous to say we now belong to Caterham Hill.

Generally the draft plan leaves Caterham and Whyteleafe under-represented and leaves wards that are too big and not enough councillors to serve the community. Residents will loose out and will have less power over decisions. There will be fewer councillors here than the rural south of the district. In the draft plan all the wards North of Tandridge are above the average and in the South all, except Burstow, are below variance which gives the rural south more representation and power.

Our councillors are a godsend and work very hard for us on various issues, they just would not be able to manage these very large wards as they are stretched as it is.
