The Boundary Commission of England has recently published proposals to change Tandridge District Council Wards, one of which is to combine Tatsfield & Titsey with Limpsfield as a three-member ward.

Your Parish Council can see many disadvantages in our particularly rural village being combined with the more urban and populated Limpsfield. As a three-member ward it would have three Councillor representatives, but they would each be voted for by the combined population.
