I am unhappy that my part of Portley would be lumped in with Whyteleafe.

Portley is in Caterham on the Hill and is a totally residential ward. Whyteleafe is in the Valley and has a totally different "feel" being more built up and commercial. I feel that it is most important that the whole of the current Portley ward is represented by a District Council ward that represents the Hill and only the Hill.

I am also unhappy that Chaldon is being lumped in with Westway. As Woldingham is having a single councillor I feel it is only fair that Chaldon also remains a separate ward with its own councillor.

Also under the proposed boundary changes the CR3 area is represented currently by 13 councillors which would be reduced to 12 under the boundary proposals. As the CR3 area has seen the biggest increase in population this cannot be right. We in the CR3 area should be represented by at least the same number of councillors if not more.

I would like to see Chaldon have its own councillor, Caterham on the Hill represented by 2 wards with 3 councillors each and the Valley (including Whyteleafe represented either by 2 wards with 3 councillors each or 3 wards with 2 councillors each. On the Hill the current wards could be split along an east/west boundary to run along say Buxton Lane and Townend with both sides of these roads being included in Caterham on the Hill East (not a suggested name merely geographical). This would mean Buxton Lane (including the airfield roads, Whyteleafe Road north of the Burnwood Lane traffic lights including all cul de sacs and new developments, Portley Lane, Matlock Road and that part of Burntwood Lane would all go into Caterham on the Hill East along with most of the current Queens Park ward.

The rest of Portley, including Ninehams Road, Foxon Lane (and all roads off Foxon Lane), Macaully Road, Addison Road, Eldon Road, Campbell Road, Milton Road and that part of Banstead Road north currently in Portley would go into Caterham on the Hill West along with the current Westway ward.

The whole of the Chaldon Road would go into Caterham Hill West as would the whole of Westway (the road) and that part of Banstead Road and roads off which are currently in Queens Park. This would have the added advantage that roads such as Banstead Road, Chaldon Road and Westway (road) are not split between wards as they currently are. Roads on the west side of the High Street and south of Chaldon Road would remain in the Queens Park area of Caterham on the Hill East - possibly to be called Queens Park and Portley ward. The Caterham Hill West area could continue to be called Westway ward. I feel that this would keep Caterham on the Hill as a whole represented by wards which only included areas in Caterham on the Hill rather than mixing up Hill with Valley.
