I strongly disagree with the proposals to move Cottingham to a new parish of Desborough, meaning that the village would have a Kettering MP. Cottingham has strong links to Corby, it takes roughly 10 minutes to walk from Cottingham to Corby. Kingswood School is the catchment area school. What schools would the children of the village go to? My own children went to Cottingham school and the Studfall schools, then to Corby Business Academy. Our local Drs.

Surgery is Lakeside. Would we be expected to move from there? I mainly shop in Corby Town Centre and the Corby supermarkets, never Desborough and extremely rarely in Kettering. If I choose to shop out of Corby it is in Market Harborough. I have no connections whatever with Desborough Or Kettering. My husband, before he retired worked all his life in Corby, as did I after I moved to the area. My daughter who lives with us in Cottingham works in Corby. As a retired woman I attend clubs and groups in Corby and attend Corby Cube Theatre and the Savoy Cinema regularly. I mostly socialise in Corby as my friends live in the Town. My older Daughter and my grandchildren all live in Corby. I have no links with Desborough or Kettering, and cannot see that I could or should be represented by them. I have nothing ideologically in common with them and do not know anyone who lives in those towns. I very strongly do not support such a change in boundaries as it would not serve me or my family at all. A previous Corby MP was instrumental in supporting my family a few years back and was able to help with an issue. I feel supported by Corby and have an affinity with the town and have always felt proud to be part of the Corby community.
