With reference to the above I would like to say that I have both resided in both Thorney Close 25 years and Hastings Hill 50 years .

Hastings Hill ,Grindon ,Thorney Close and Springwell all share a common park extension green space .This is a focal point for all the community uniting all four estates rather than dividing them . Where young and old can enjoy local fresh air pursuits .

Hastings Hill ,Grindon ,Thorney Close and Springwell all share a secondary school in Sandhill View . Infant and Junior schools in Hastings Hill , Grindon and Thorney Close . Share medical facilities at Springwell Medical Centre , Grindon Primary Care Centre and Local chemists .

There are very good walking , cycling and transport links . The buses link all estates to most parts of Sunderland .

All four estates are all served by the same community groups , churches and youth activities at the Grindon Young Peoples Centre .

All churches run children and adult activities . Also is the 111 Squadron Air Cadets based in Tay Road .

There are no community or public transport links between Hastings Hill and Grindon which border both Pennywell and South Hylton areas to the North .

The A183 dual carriage way trunk road provides a hard boundary between Hastings Hill / Grindon and Pennywell / South Hylton with no suitable safe crossing .

In closing , all four estates have a wonderful community spirit . Lots of people marry and move houses but choose to stay in their community . There is no empathy with Pennywell and South Hylton and believe this is purely political .I would like you to review these changes as I see no benefit .
