I am just registering at this stage. I do have issues about the control of election procedures for Council Wards, both current and if revised. Like many Bradfordians I suspect that there is widespread abuse of the Postal Vote system ... particularly as there are so many easily-accessed polling stations open from early morning to late night. The Council has never disclosed any forensic audit of postal votes.

I consider that no more than all voting slips should have an individual signature and actually be posted in a stamped addressed envelope ... no more than three votes per envelope.

In the runup to a General Election several years ago, in the foyer of City Hall awaiting a meeting, I saw an individual deliver a large unsealed cardboard box to the reception counter. The deliverer was not asked to sign anything to confirm the handover.

Rightly or wrongly, I assumed the box contained postal voting slips. I would like the Council to spell out if such practice is allowed.
