NEW ELECTORAL ARRANGEMENTS

January 2024

Currently there are:

- 64 councillors
- 3 two-member divisions and
 58 single-member divisions

A public consultation is open until I April 2024



We aim to make sure Derbyshire councillors represent a similar number of electors



Currently there are:

- 9 divisions that are more than
 10% away from the average
 number of electors per division
- I division that is more than 30% away from the average

We are proposing:

- 64 councillors
- 64 divisions
- I councillor per division



Our proposals mean that:

- 3 divisions will be more than 10% away from the average number of electors per division
- Each councillor will represent an average of 10,617 electors
