**Related subject:** STURRY

The Growth estimates for Sturry indicate an increase in excess of 2600 electors (42% growth on the 2023 totals). This huge jump in numbers will put considerable strain on the local infrastructure and services without significant investment and incentives. The A28 passing through Sturry and crossing the Sturry Level Crossing is already a significant bottleneck to traffic travelling to and from Canterbury. Slow traffic congestion and environmental impacts will be detrimental to all residents and those passing through the ward. Local medical services will need to be strengthened and more service should be available locally avoiding travel into/across Canterbury. Sturry will need a local medical centre/cottage hospital. Local food availability should be supported and subsidised to allow, non supermarket, small accessible farm shops to support the local communities, giving them access to affordable, local grown, seasonal produce. The car parking on the A28 in Sturry should be addressed. A car park/off road parking for local residents and commuters using Sturry station should be facilitated. This would clear the route for buses, as well as commercial and private vehicles which are regularly delayed by parked vehicles on this single carriageway.
