It is very difficult to give one's views on the electoral review when one does not know what is being proposed by the review. All I am able to find is the current state of the boundaries. There are some significant anomalies in these, particularly in the number of councillors per electorate and the drawing of geographical boundaries.

Blean Forest is clearly an anomaly as it has far too many councillors. I think the purpose of the review should be to ensure that all variances are minimised, ideally to less than 5%, and certainly that no variance is greater than 10%.

Geographically speaking, clear lines that follow roads are preferable to boundaries that diverge because of roads. An example of this is Nackington Road where it crosses the A2. One would have expected the A2 to form a natural boundary.
