I am sad to learn of rumours that some officials have decided that Hastings Hill and Grindon estates should be lumped together with Pennywell and South Hylton to accommodate Local Government Boundary Commission plans.

Hastings Hill where I have lived for 34 years and Grindon for 28 years where I grew up, have always been part of a group that includes Thorney Close and Springwell and I see no valid reason to change that.

Residents of our estates go to the same schools, shops, clubs and pubs. We are a community served by our own councillors, people we know and trust.

The A183 acts as a boundary between the estates where safe pedestrian access is only possible via a traffic light crossing at the top of the Grindon Lane / Chester Road junction.

South Hylton is no where near Hastings Hill or Grindon and would be a better fit with Ford Estate and Pennywell where common bus routes serve those communities.
