Comment text:

In general, boundaries should be realigned where large scale housing growth has in effect extended towns into rural divisions. The large scale housing growth between Didcot and the A34 should be in Didcot divisions, not Harwell (although I suspect this will be ruled out due to district boundaries) - consider realigning Didcot to North (or the railway line), West (moving eastern boundary further west and west boundary to A34) and Central ((including the western part of Didcot East - the eastern part perhaps belongs better with Cholsey). Cumnor is very edge of city - doesn't seem to have much in common with Shellingford etc. Some could be moved to Faringdon. Carterton should be separate from the very rural Burford. Completely different issues. The rural bit south of Carterton could be extended to take Clanfield, Bampton etc to reduce size of Witney West. Hanborough has grown so much, and feels much more like an Oxford suburb; once you get past North Leigh - so to Ramsden, Minster Lovell, Leafield - there is a much more Cotswold / rural focus, more in common with Charlbury and Wychwoods. These parishes could be transferred, given growth of Hanborough.
