Mayfield and Five Ashes Parish Council have made their submissions to Wealden District Council about the proposed Ward Boundary changes. The Parish recommendation has been ignored in part by Wealden. Mayfield and Five Ashes ward, as proposed by Wealden, has an electorate of 2865, which is minus 2% from the 2909 average figure. The Parish requests that Rushers Cross, which includes Lake Street and Tidebrook and has 239 electors, is included in the Mayfield and Five Ashes ward. This will give a total of 3014 electors, which is only 6.7% above the required average figure. The reason we are requesting this is because the electorate within Rushers Cross have always been part of the Mayfield and Five Ashes Parish, they share the same community, churches, schools, doctors, post office and even cast their votes in Mayfield along with the other residents of Mayfield. They have little or nothing to do with Wadhurst or Frant with whom they are to be allied under the Wealden proposal.
