Comment text:

It is important that ward boundaries reflect communities. To achieve an approximate equality of voters per councillor this is currently achieved by having 1, 2 or 3 councillors per ward according to the size of the electorate. This is far more important than having all wards with 3 councillors, which is merely for administrative convenience and thus relatively unimportant. It is accepted that with changes in population and the reduction in the number of councillors from 58 to 54 there will need to be some adjustment to ward boundaries, but preserving the community focused wards must be the overriding consideration albeit that it will not result in all wards having three councillors.
