
Currently there are:

- 50 councillors
- 30 wards
- 6 three-councillor wards, 8 two-councillor wards and 16 single-councillor wards

A public consultation is open until 9 May 2022



We aim to make sure East Hertfordshire councillors represent a similar number of electors



- I3 wards that are more than
 I0% away from the average
 number of electors per ward
- 2 wards that is more than
 20% away from the average

We are proposing:

- 50 councillors
- 26 wards
- 6 three-councillor wards, 12 two-councillor wards and 8 single-councillor wards



Our proposals mean that:

- No wards will be more than 10% away from the average number of electors per ward
- Each councillor will represent an average of 2,640 electors
