I disagree with the Commission's recommendation recommendation to include Deane's Park Road within the proposed new Fareham Town Ward. I know this area very well and the residents are linked to the Cams area as homes on one side of the road back on to Fareham Creek and the Cams estate..Rear gardens of homes on the other side of Deane's Park Road back onto the railway line then the A27 main road, Eastern Way which separate the residential road from what will be Fareham Town Ward. I submit that for these reasons Deane's Park Road should be placed in the Wallington and Downend Ward. 2.Portchester Wicor proposals . My husband and I moved into █████ Quintrel Avenue , Portchester in December 1970 when it was brand new and moved to my present home in 1987. During that time there were open fields behind the house, but there is now a Persimmon homes development there, adjacent to Wicor Primary School. Our son attended Wicor Primary School which was a short walk away. We regarded ourselves as living in Portchester and walked to the shops there. I believe that ,if possible numerically, consideration should be given to Romsey Avenue, with the proposed homes to the south which will be accessed from Romsey Avenue, plus the 'Ideal Homes' estate built from the late 1960s until 1971: Ashstead Close, Merrow Close, Rudgewick Close, Stoneleigh Close, Quintrel Avenue and Hatherley Crescent being within Portchester Wicor rather than Wallington and Downend.
