Catisfield: Proposed Ward boundary changes.

I write to object strongly against the decision to divide the Catisfield community by the proposed change in Ward boundaries.

This is a small historic community that has been established for many generations. It is based on the original ribbon development along this small section of what was the main A27 road between Fareham and Southampton. In its early development, well over 100 years ago, there were a number of large residences, horticultural establishments and smaller homes for local workers comprising the area of Catisfield. Despite subsequent development and re-routing of the road, this remains a cohesive residential area in which local people have worked hard to maintain a perpetually active community.

Catisfield has long-established links with Titchfield and the Meon Valley. Indeed, significant parts of our community extend into the conservation area of the Meon Valley. The countryside and the roads all directly impact on our local environment and are key to the history of this small community.

The close ties between the community, the Catisfield Memorial Hall and the Catisfield Village Association are evidenced by their identical respective constituency area.

The current change in Ward boundaries would split this small community and destroy its cohesion.

The changes are wholly unacceptable and should be amended to reflect the long-established community of Catisfield in accordance with the Fareham Borough Council's submission advocating that this community be included in the new Meon Ward (replacing the previous Titchfield Ward).
