Comment text:

I refer to the Portchester Boundaries. I think the proposed boundaries split Portchester the wrong way. The proposals split the area east / west when the natural split is north / south. The north which is hilly forms its own community with schools and two stores serving the residents. There are also stores and food outlets in the Leith Road area which is just inside Portsmouth but does serve the northern part of Portchester. Most of the housing on the hill is post 1960s where the southern part of the area is mostly pre war and has a conservation area around the castle. The southern area has a number of shops in White Hart Lane and the precinct which serves this area. The boundaries which split east / west split both communities in half. The boundaries also split roads which would be very confusing to residents I think a better option would be to have a north / south split with the boundary either running along the railway line or A27. This of course will depend upon the number of electors. This in my view would be a far more logical split than your proposal.
