I do not think the proposals with regard to the above meet the criteria: are appropriate, and reflect community ties and identities, informed by local needs, views and circumstances. The other criteria for me are met. Portchester has always identified as north and south (e.g. Northern Primary school), naturally separated by A27/The railway/The Crossway in my lifetime of living in Portchester for 50+ years. The east-west was always false but tolerated. Now lopping off the area around myself into 'Downend' is artificial since the community focus for the area around The Thicket/Winnham is Portchester (walking distance). The proposed map is still lumpy and not east west at all. It appears to comply with lazy labelling not geography as bad as that it replaced.
