### Comment text:

"Boundary Commission Consultation - East Hertfordshire - Brickendon Liberty Parish As it currently stands the Hertford Heath ward includes the parishes of Hertford Heath and Brickendon Liberty notwithstanding the fact there are in effect no physical direct road connections, nor has there been any inter-action historically or currently between the two parishes. By comparison, the adjacent parishes of Bayford, Little Berkhamstead are not only well linked by road and geographically well aligned, they are also very similar in electorate size. The parishes have similar interests and challenges they need to manage and among other things Bayford and Little Berkhamstead have to date co-operated on the procurement of assets which are shared on an as and when needed basis. Little Berkhamstead and Brickendon Liberty also have the same Parish Clerk who also has a close working relationship with the Clerk of Bayford parish. Accordingly we would propose that Brickendon Liberty parish be joined with Bayford and Little Berkhamstead to form a new Ward. Similarly given the more relevant road links and geographical proximity to each other it would appear that the current Hertford Heath ward may well be better served by Hertford Heath being linked to Great Amwell and Stanstead St Margarets and the Tewin Ward realigned and linked with Hertingfordbury."
