Wallsend Ward's current boundaries are well aligned with natural geographic features and Newcastle City Council. The Tyne River is to the south, the Coast Road to the north, the open space of the Wallsend Burn to the east and Newcastle City Council to the West. Wallsend Ward elector population is currently within 10% of the ideal number of electors and the predicted number is also within 10% of the ideal number. There is also the proposed Bellway development of over 200 homes, which could potentially add 200-400 electors. This would see Wallsend at around the ideal number of electors. If Wallsend Ward needed to be expanded, then the natural expansion would be to the west, to include the area from High View (current western boundary) towards Station Road further to the west. If it needed even further expansion, then expansion towards West Street would be most logical, as this is clearly one cohesive community. Any other expansion of Wallsend does not make a cohesive community. Please listen to the residents of Wallsend who wish their Ward to include those residents in Queens Crescent and Station Road, if any expansion is required. I have attached an image that shows where the boundary should be expanded to, west towards Station Road or West Street, if it needs expanding.
