As far as possible (and subject to one caveat listed below), all councillors should represent the same number of electors. Ward boundaries are artificial, and should not be retained because e.g. they correspond to historical parish boundaries if this results in inconsistencies in representation. The one caveat is that Paddock Wood and Southborough have their own Town Councils which have their own budgets. As a consequence, and by analogy with representation in Westminster in those parts of the country with devolved administrations, these areas should have less representation on the Borough Council than other parts of the Borough.
