### Comment text:

There seems to be a mismatch of communication with this whole thing. Has someone not told you that huge new developments are planned on the west side of Cheltenham? This could see the population of the current wards of Springbank, Hesters Way and Swindon Village double before 6 years is up. As for right now, 2022, other than a slight bias towards the western suburbs for new streets, the proportions of the ward populations can't have changed that much since the last major review in 1999. So, hadn't you better wait for a few years before enacting any changes? Once the so called Golden Valley development is under way, the actual Borough boundary may be extended (substantially), so, some kind of review would become essential then, anyway. Also, you had better work in consultation with the parliamentary boundary review, since they too are looking at our ward boundaries. As things stand with current proposals, the new Golden Valley estates would be split between (on the southern half) Cheltenham and (the northern half) Tewkesbury constituencies. This is far from ideal, but I'm not sure what alternative is being suggested yet. In any case, you don't want to create a situation where the parliamentary constituency boundary cuts across a ward boundary. (By the way, your map of current boundaries on this website doesn't seem to work: it's just a block of pink squares).
