Comment text:

The wedged area between Leckhampton and Charlton Kings should be 'parished', so it can benefit from the services provided by Parish Councils. Charlton Kings Common should be reincorporated into Charlton Kings Parish. The easiest way to do this would be to reinstate roughly the boundary of the old Charlton Kings Rural District Council between Charlton Kings and Leckhampton. Much of this land is taken up by the Lilley Brook Golf Course and Charlton Kings Common, so the main populations affected would be Charlton Park, the houses on the West side of the Cirencester Road and up Sandy Lane. If a majority of residents of Charlton Park do not want to be incorporated into Charlton Kings, they could be incorporated into the College Parish.
