I live in the part of Twyford parish ([REDACTED]) that is annexed to Hurst Parish for the purpose of Wokingham Borough Council councillor elections. Whilst I have no objection to this arrangement for borough elections it does have a serious implication on the election of Twyford Parish council members. At the last parish council elections I was offered no choice but the two unopposed candidates presented, whose views I may not have agreed with, whilst the rest of the Twyford electorate were offered to make a choice between a variety of candidates for the remaining 13 seats on the parish council.

This is grossly unfair, I believe that for Twyford Parish Council elections the parish should be treated as a whole and that the annexed area should be included in an inclusive list of candidates for election. This would enable me to make an informed choice between all candidates for election to the parish council.
