Comment text:

The Ware N&E development really means that Ware Town ward boundaries need to change. Unfortunately this will require changes at every level of government from General elections, county, district and town. The principle should be that Ware Town should encompass the whole of the new development. In practice this should also include the Fanhams Hall area and Moles Farm. Otherwise we'll continue to have the situation where the ward boundaries cut across roads and housing in the middle of a housing estate that self evidently part of Ware Town. I would recommend keeping the existing boundary to the S and W. At the River Lee in the SE, follow the line of the old Buntingford railway to the Meridian. Then follow the Meridian due North to a point on the same line of latitude as just N of Moles farm. Then follow the line due West to the A10. Within this new town boundary, then adjust the existing wards to equalise the population, with Ware Trinity and Ware Christchurch expanding and moving N and E respectively. The attached file is a rough diagram of where the boundary should be.
