### Comment text:

I live at Oaktree Gardens, [REDACTED] which sits in the Harlow Common ward. However I access my house via the Church Langley estate, use Church Langley in my postal address and care about, have concerns over activities within the Church Langley estate. Potter Street is a local community hub that I can easily access and indeed use on some occasions. It provides me with resources unavailable on a new build estate.
