Harlow has expanded significantly since the last review, principally in the East. This area is under represented and looking at the Elector population to the East of the natural boundary formed by the A414/A1184 should have three wards. No wards should cross this major highway system. This means that the artificial Ward of Harlow Common should be split. The new eastern wards should comprise Old Harlow bounded by Gilden Way. A new ward Newhall & Church Langley North and a ward of Church Langley South & Potter Street. This is both logical and in line with improving electoral equality.
