

Dear Sir/Madam,

I write in response to your consultation regarding your proposed new ward boundaries, for Bracknell Forest Borough Council.

As one of the ward Councillors for Great Hollands South I mostly support your proposals for Western Bracknell. However I would like to draw your attention to a peculiarity/discrepancy in the current boundary between Great Hollands North and Great Hollands South, which your proposal carries forward to your new boundary between Great Hollands and Binfield South with Jennetts Park. Namely that the classrooms of Easthampstead Park Community School fall into a different ward than the school's playing fields.

I therefore encourage you, rather than leaving the boundary running along the school drive and effectively cutting the school in two you instead take it along the northern edge of the playing field as illustrated below.



Also you will note I use the name Jennett's Park and not Jennett's Hill, as this is the name by which this community has been known since the area was first developed. As is reflected in the name of the Estate's Primary School and Community Centre.
