As a resident of Spital, I live on [REDACTED], I object to your latest proposal for the changes to the Ward boundaries in my area. I do not believe that putting Spital in the Hasland Ward is a good recommendation. As a resident of Spital I do not align myself with Hasland but with the area we are now in, including Hady. Hady and Spital have much better associations and are linked with numerous local footpaths allowing easy access between the two communities. The local bus links the two, both with journeys to the town centre and to the local hospital. Most residents use our local shop or go into the town centre, local surgeries and clinics are either in the town centre or at the hospital. Most local primary children go to Hady School as it can be safely accessed via local paths.
